Archie Goodman told Nero Wolfe that he used the possible existence of a silver abacus owned by Paul Revere to gain an interview with a wealthy businessman. Paul Revere never owned a silver abacus but the possibilities of such an item triggered the imagination that allowed for the interview.

During the publication of this book I spoke to three men. Each man made a negative comment regarding reading. One man said that no one would read each individual name on the list in the book. The second man said no one would purchase the books because people were too busy worrying about money to read or to purchase a book. In hard times no one buys books. What American woman would be interested in what I had to say to purchase a book? The third man said some of the books were too large that no woman would take the time to read the books. He said the number of pages in each book would immediately No woman or man would purchase a book turn women off. consisting of four hundred to five hundred pages. Needless to say I was disheartened for a second. Then I sat and thought about their comments. Their words were not complimentary to women or to people in general. They believe that there is nothing to life during hard times but meat and potatoes. Gravness had descended on the earth. Life was so brutal that reading could be ignored. I decided to persevere. These men had to be wrong. I continued to believe that reading, regardless of the number of pages in a book, is seen as an activity that enriches the soul and enlightens the mind. It leads men and women to greater and greater heights and inventions. The fate of America will be decided by how well we nourish our minds and assimilate information to continue our growth.

Introduction

When You Walk In the Light You Are Part of the Body of Christ

It is important that you believe in yourself. Your success in life or your failure in life depends upon your belief in yourself. Who you will fight, how long you fight, and the tools you use to fight will all depend upon your believing in yourself. If we take a closer look at what you believe or do not believe, we will see that your beliefs also affect the lives of your wife, your children, or your husband. So you see, your belief system encompasses your entire existence. Your belief system is so important that you should always be concerned with what thoughts are being fed to you by the people who are around you, and what information you receive through news sources. You cannot take a cavalier attitude toward your associates or toward the person who reports the news. People have committed suicide because they believed the hopelessness reported by the reporters on television: the stock market is going to crash, there are no jobs, you are going to lose your home, there will be food lines throughout the country, all the computers in the country are going to crash. There is nothing man can do. The pestilence is upon us. Disasters are inevitable. Run, death is upon us! This type of soothsaying is dangerous; it is debilitating and it causes people to become sick at heart. Defeat settles in and death of the spirit or death of the body soon follows. If you remain around people who speak hate and negativity, soon violence settles in and destruction follows.

There have been men who have committed murder because they believed their act would be acceptable by the people around them. These men gambled with eternal damnation, thinking they had the approval of their community. These men committed vile acts because they refused to change their friends or their thinking. Now these men are in prison for the rest of their lives. Did not their belief system affect their lives and the lives of their wives and children? What child do you know would want to visit his or her parent in prison? The child wants to see the parent at home, on the playground, or in a mall, not in a prison where they cannot touch one another or truly have a human experience together. What child do you know wants to try and explain to his or her friends that their father is a murderer? Imagine explaining to your friends how your father beheaded a man (Garnett P. Johnson Jr., ex-marine) and burned him alive because of his race. Imagine being the judge who heard the case, the prosecutor who did not seek the death penalty, or the all-white jury who had to decide the guilt in the case. No child wants to say that his or her father is a murderer or that his or her mother is a liar. The child wants to say: My father is a police officer. My father is a firefighter. My father is a mailman. My father is a man who works and takes care of his family. My father is a man of character and integrity and I am proud of him. No child wants to say: My father is a murderer.

There is a man in Missouri on death row who committed his first murder at the age of 27, all because of what he believed. To date, he has confessed to twenty <u>murders</u>, six <u>aggravated</u> <u>assaults</u>, sixteen <u>bank robberies</u>, and two <u>bombings</u>. This man will never get out of prison; in another twenty or thirty years he

will die and his daughter will have spent almost her entire life without her father, all because of what he believed. Didn't this child deserve to have a father in the home whom she could turn to when she needed him rather than visiting him in prison (if she is indeed visiting him)?

What you believe can make you a fool, or what you believe can make you a genius. You should be concerned about where on the spectrum you fall. Your thoughts and conclusions are developed from information that you receive from outside sources and digest as truth and fact, or from information that you reject as false. It behooves you to question what you believe because this is the basis for your advancement through life or your decline in life. To end up in prison because of your beliefs is extreme; ending up in the gutter because of what you believe is also extreme, yet quite possible.

Can you not see the danger involved in allowing your mind to be exposed to a type of conversation that will lead you to hatred and murder, envy, and jealousy? As long as you sit at the lunch table or stand in the backyard talking about people, jealousy and envy will be the results of your conversation. You talk about your neighbor's new car. You talk about your neighbor's new couch. Pretty soon, you decide you want a new car like your neighbor or you want a new couch like your neighbor. So you begin to connive and arrange situations so that you can talk to your neighbor's husband, maybe meet him for a drink. Finally you are in bed with him because your true objective is a new car and a new couch. As time progresses, your desires may change and you will attempt to replace his wife after all (See The Recidivist Volume Four Part II).

You convince yourself that his wife is the problem. You justify your behavior by saying that you are the better woman. Not once do you see yourself for what you are: a mean-spirited, envious, and jealous woman who is willing to do anything to destroy the object of her jealousy and hate: his wife. You refuse to believe that what you want is to be exactly like her. You formulated this hateful plan because you were angry that no man has been willing to provide you with a new car or a new couch. You decide to get what you want through deceit and subterfuge. You refuse to believe that the reason why the man provides for his wife is because she has served him as a wife; she has made him feel necessary in her life. She is his center. Since you are deceitful, you lie to the world and to yourself. You continue with your plan, never realizing that the first murder ever committed in the world was committed because of jealousy. You follow in Cain's footsteps. The story of Cain and Abel is not a folk tale. It is a lesson to be learned, not to let your emotions rule you. Cain murdered his brother Abel because Cain was jealous. Both men made offerings unto the Lord, but only Cain's offering was insufficient. Abel gave the first and the best of what he had as an offering. Cain just gave his first, but not his best. So Cain brooded and became angry and judged that his brother should die for this slight. The Bible says, Cain was very wroth, and his countenance fell. Cain could not tolerate, stand for, or put up with the fact that Abel had bested him. It never occurred to Cain that Abel did not have him in mind when he made his offering to the Lord. Abel was trying to please the Lord, not to compete with Cain. The affront was too much to bear. God spoke to Cain: "Why art thou wroth? And why is thy countenance fallen? If thou doeth well, shalt thou not be accepted? And if thou doeth not well, sin lieth at the door. And unto thee shall be his desire, and thou shalt rule over him." God told Cain not to let his emotions rule him, but Cain did not listen and he slew his brother. The Devil led Cain right through the doorway of sin by using the tool of jealousy, making Cain the most infamous man in history. Cain became the world's first murderer.

On February 1, 1988, Mrs. Sheila Doll, 24, was shot to death in her husband's apartment in Houston, Texas. She had come to Houston on January 29, 1988, from Chicago, Illinois to reconcile with her husband. She had been separated from her husband for about fourteen months. Her husband, Paul Doll, 27, was working as an accountant in Houston. He last spoke to his wife at 10:45 a.m. on February 1, 1988. Mrs. Doll's body was found at noon the same day by the apartment manager who had come to her apartment to change the locks. Mr. Doll had requested the locks be changed because he suspected that his ex-girlfriend had keys to his apartment. On February 2, 1988 his ex-girlfriend, Christine Ilene Larson, 24, was charged with murder. The maintenance man saw Christine Larson arrive and leave the apartment building the day of the murder. Ms. Larson was a school teacher for the Aldine Independent School District. She had once dated Mr. Doll. After she was arrested, Homicide Sgt. W.O. Allen said, "Obviously it's a crime of passion. Certainly jealousy would be involved. She had an attachment to the victim's husband and didn't want to break off that relationship. . . It should have been a time of anticipation of a brighter future for (the Dolls), but it just turned into a tragedy."

Christine Larson said the shooting was an accident. She went to the murder victim's apartment carrying a gun. She forced her way into the apartment and by accident she shot Mrs. Doll in the back. Why did she take the gun to the woman's apartment, and why was she in the apartment? How was the shooting an accident when she forced her way into the apartment? How was Mrs. Sheila Doll accidentally shot in the back? Christine Larson had no right to be in the apartment. Her ex-boyfriend had told her that he wanted to reconcile with his wife. He asked her to leave before his wife arrived. Several times Christine Larson threatened to kill herself during their brief relationship. Every

time Paul Doll tried to end their relationship, Christine Larson would threaten suicide. After this gambit did not work, her only recourse was to kill Mrs. Doll. The fact is that when Christine Larson could not hold onto Mr. Paul Doll after threatening suicide, the next step was to use force against his wife. Shortly before the murder, Christine Larson called Mrs. Doll's father in Glenville, Illinois and asked him if Sheila Doll was home. He told her that his daughter was in Texas. This was how Christine Larson learned that Ms. Doll was in Texas. How did she get the phone number?

On June 23, 1989, Christine Larson was convicted of involuntary manslaughter. The conviction of involuntary manslaughter meant that Mrs. Dolls' death did not matter that much to the jury. Homicide Sgt. Waymon Allen, who investigated the case, was disappointed with the conviction and sentence: "I think an involuntary manslaughter conviction shows life isn't worth much. Any Harris County Jail inmate under indictment for murder would plead guilty for two years in prison." During his final arguments, Assistant District Attorney Claire Connors said that Larson should have the words "fatal attraction" branded on her forehead. He described Christine Larson as a "cold-blooded murderer" who left her romantic rival bleeding to death and never called for help.

During the murder trial, Christie Larson fainted in the courtroom. Apparently this symbolized how overcome she was with remorse. If the shooting was an accident, why didn't Christine Larson call an ambulance, instead of leaving the apartment and allowing Sheila Doll to bleed to death on the floor? On January 9, 1988, Christine Larson purchased a Raven pistol for \$50.96 and a box of .25-caliber ammunition for \$12.31. Why did she buy this second gun?

Is it not possible that when Christine Larson called Mr. Doll's sister and her friend from jail, that she was trying to garner support for herself? She wanted people to think that she was just a poor, misunderstood, love-smitten woman who did something foolish but should not be punished too severely. Yet her rival was dead, never to see her husband again. What did Christine Larson think: that Paul Doll would again invite her into his life? "I killed your wife, now we can live happily ever after." What?

The murder of Mrs. Sheila Doll is an example of extreme thought. When Mr. Doll did not initiate divorce proceedings against his wife, that was clear evidence that he did not want to marry Christine Larson, even though she had moved in with Mr. Doll after his wife left Texas for Illinois. Christie Larson tried to supplant Sheila Doll. She could not. In time Paul Doll asked Christine Larson to leave his apartment. He wanted nothing more to do with her than occasional sex. When Christine Larson called Mrs. Doll's father and asked for Sheila Doll, Christine Larson knew that she was the loser and that Mrs. Doll was the winner. Christine Larson was the third party in the marriage. She did not belong. Marriage is defined by God as a covenant between a man and a woman that is inviolable. To interfere in a marriage is a sin. To participate in adultery is a sin. Do you see how the thinking of both Christine Larson and Mr. Paul Doll led to the death of Sheila Doll? Do you see how their belief system and lack of character caused another person injury? By the way, Mr. Doll testified in court that Ms. Christine Larson drove him to the airport several times when he flew to see his wife in Chicago, but he kept having sex with Ms. Larson on occasion. If Mr. Doll was flying to Illinois to see his wife, he had to know her phone number, where she was living, etcetera. Mr. Doll had to have been communicating with his wife on more than one occasion. He was initiating contact.

Why would a woman persist in a relationship when she is the third party? Low self-esteem and the sense of competition pure and simple. "I am going to be the winner."

Christine Larson knew that Mr. Doll was not only talking to his wife, he was making trips to see her. Clearly there was no room in his life for Christine Larson, except for a few minutes for an occasional roll in the hay. Like most women, Christine Larson placed too much emphasis on sex. Having sex with a man does not make you his wife, nor does it put you in line to be his wife. All having sex with a man means is that you had sex, nothing more. Only a commitment to one another through marriage is a meaningful act. Christine tried everything she could to hold on to this relationship, including threatening suicide. When this ploy did not work, her final weapon was murder. At no time during Christine Larson's trial did Paul Doll say that he loved and needed her or that he wanted her to be his wife. These words never came from his lips, proving that a woman should watch what a man does, not listen to what a man says. Paul Doll went to find his wife; he did not establish a covenant with Christine Larson. He had sex with Christine Larson, but he did not establish a covenant with her. He did not speak words of sanctity and righteousness over their union. Hundreds of women are now entering prison for life because for all of their plotting they could not supplant the wife so they used murder to finish the equation. The greatest illusion in the world is held by women, I can supplant the wife by using sex. When the gambit does not work the woman chooses to murder the wife. The interloper never says to herself that her judgment was faulty, that she had no right to interfere in the affairs of two people who were bound together legally and morally. interloper never says to herself, "I entered into this relationship because it made me feel good knowing I was taking another woman's place." The interloper never became angry with the male because he was making her work harder to prove her affection for him, e.g. tolerate the presence of another woman in his life while having sex with her. Every night he goes home to his wife or pregnant girlfriend but he tells you he loves you. It is the wife's fault for wanting to continue the relationship. The wife should realize it is time for you to take the front and center stage. You are the love of his life and you are going to prove it by killing the wife and marrying the husband boyfriend. Right! The man is just the poor misunderstood soul and the wife is the big bad demon in the equation. Eliminate the wife and all will go well.

You can end up living on the street after years of committing You can end up on the streets or in prison after having sex with a married man or a man who is engaged to another woman. You can end up on the streets after years of cheating your customers. You can end up on the streets after years of betraying your friends. All actions are based on what you believe. When you commit adultery, you believe that lying to your wife or husband is alright. When you sleep with a man who is committed to another woman you are telling yourself you will be the winner after everything is said and done. The other woman is the problem and soon she will be gone and you will live happily ever after with her husband or boyfriend. When you cheat your customers, you believe that your actions are just business. When you betray your friends, you believe that betrayal is acceptable. By the time you end up on the street or in prison, you finally realize that your arrival in the gutter was because of what you believed. It is possible that Ms. Larson was paroled after serving only a few years in prison and that the school system gave her a second chance. Mrs. Sheila Doll is forever dead. Ms. Larson is probably married now with children, but Mrs. Sheila Doll is forever dead. And for what? All because Christine Larson was in love with Mrs. Doll's husband and refused to end the relationship as the loser. When you leave your mind up to the Devil, destruction and chaos will soon follow you.

Shannon Crawley of North Carolina is now in prison for the rest of her life because she chose to murder Denita Smith her perceived rival. Sonya Daniels of West Virginia is now in prison for the rest of her life for the murder of her rival and child, Deanna M. Pritchard, 16, of Walkersville, Maryland and her daughter Makayla A. Frost, 5 weeks. She shot the child while she lay on the ground. How is that for self hate? Sonya Daniels barely escaped the death penalty. Carl Hughes of Mississippi also faced the death penalty for shooting and stabbing Avis Banks who was five months pregnant, her rival. Avis Banks was living with Carla Hughes' so called boyfriend. Carla Hughes earned a PhD. She was a more than competent teacher but she allowed her thinking and self esteem to be manipulated by a man who was only looking for sexual trysts while his girlfriend was pregnant.

One of the most insidious plots to murder a rival involved the murder of Kennis C. Falconer, 26, who was 7 months pregnant. (the rivalry is only in the mind of the interloper). Ramieka T. Fowler, 23 and Bianca Coleman, 21, posed as Mary Kay saleswomen to enter the apartment of Kennis Falconer in Takoma Park. The women stabbed Ms. Falconer to death. Bianca Coleman was dating Kennis Falconer's fiance, Jason Smallwood. Bianca Coleman had to get rid of Kennis Falconer before she had the baby. She told the arresting officers she planned to ask Jason Smallwood to marry her New Years Day. How is that for a fantasy? This diabolical plot did not land the women in prison for the rest of their life. Ramieka Fowler was

just helping out a friend. Who will hire or marry these women once they leave prison? Look at the way they think.

You do not have to end up in the gutter alone, without friends or family. The journey through life can be kind and fair, based on what you believe. You can live a life of ups and downs. You can live a life filled with happiness and sadness, and you can live a life with dignity and pride. In order to live this life with dignity and pride, you will have to have a belief system greater than the system given to you by man. You will have to have a belief system based upon the light: a system based on a God who will not fail you, a God who is the same today as He was vesterday and as He will be tomorrow. The world told Mrs. Karen K. Coleman that money was so important it was worth murdering her husband for it. So On October 22, 1992, she hired James K. Korhardt and Steven A Mueller to beat her husband to death in his home. The men took Mr. Danny H. Coleman, 38, to a field and set him and his truck on fire. July 2010 a federal prosecutor brought Mr. Korhardt and Mr. Mueller, both 50 year old, and Mrs. Coleman, now 55 years old, into court to answer to the charges of murder, conspiracy to murder and murder for hire. All were convicted. Mrs. Coleman and the two men were seduced by the thought of money now they shall spend their remaining days in prison. They listened to the world.

You can find this system of light by reading the Bible. Reading the Bible and speaking God's words until His word becomes a part of the fabric of your life is what leads you to the light and a great harvest in life. One of the best ways to clarify your thinking is to read the Bible to find direction; when you do not know what to do, read the Bible to find the solution to your problem. If you do not know what job to take, read the Bible. If you do not know who to marry, read the Bible. If you are tempted to murder, read your Bible. The answer lies within.

The Bible has fascinating answers that will stimulate your thinking and clarify your belief system. Exposing your mind to the word of God is far better than listening to the soap operas on television, using their dialogue to decide whether you should divorce your husband or just take a lover. Looking to God for an answer to improve your business is far better than cheating your customers. Asking God to help heal your marriage is far better than committing adultery and murdering your husband, which will only lead to pain and hurt for your family and children. Here are a few verses from the Bible that will bolster your belief and lead you to the light. Stop to think can prevent evil acts. Do not let your errant emotions lead you to barbaric acts.

Matthew 16:18 -19 And so I tell you, Peter, you are a rock, and on this rock foundation I will build my church, and not even death will ever be able to overcome it. I will give you the keys of the Kingdom of heaven; what you prohibit on earth will be prohibited in heaven, and what you permit on earth will be permitted in heaven.

John 14:12-14 I am telling you the truth: those who believe in me will do what I do - yes I am going to the father. And I will do whatever you ask for in my name, so that the Father's glory will be shown through the Son. If you ask me for anything in my name, I will do it.

Philippians 4:19 And with all his abundant wealth through Christ Jesus, my God shall supply all my needs. God shall supply me a good mate, employment, requirements, business, lack, necessities, occasions, wants, uses, and needful uses. God shall supply me with the people I need in my life to succeed, supply me with the knowledge to raise my children correctly, God shall supply me with patience to be a good husband, father, or wife.

As you read the Bible, please realize that the Bible is a book filled with seed: seed which you can use to harvest what you want in life. **Philippians 4:19** is a seed which you plant in your heart. As you continue to say this verse, it will take root in your spirit and soon you will see a harvest. When you are seeking change, prosperity, or healing in your life, you must find a scripture in the Bible relating to your situation, and then you say this scripture out loud. The act of speaking your seed will plant the information in your heart. The words will grow and take root until the word is finally manifested into your life. You must forecast what you want in your life. Do not leave your life to the whims of the world. "By his stripes I am healed" is a seed that you plant in your heart. You repeat it to yourself often until it takes root and manifests in your life. **Jeremiah 29:11** says,

"For I know the plans I have for you' declares the LORD, 'plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future." The most resounding verse in the Bible is thou shall not kill. Murder brings disaster to your door as well as to the door of the victim. The best advice in the world is to walk away from evil thoughts. Do not let these thoughts fester and bring you to destruction. Take heed to the warnings in the Bible. The Bible is for your guidance and your protection. When you follow the world, this guidance and protection takes a back seat to your desires. Avoiding God's word is an error in judgment. You do not wait until you are age sixty and arthritic to start taking castor oil when you know at age 20 that castor oil is good for the heart, lungs, and bones.

What we need to conduct our lives can be found in the Bible. Our wholeness, soundness, and peace can be found in God's word. You can sow what you lack in your life with your mouth. Saying is sowing. When you say God's blessing is working in your life, find a complimentary scripture and repeat this

scripture until it is planted into your spirit. Whatever you say to yourself is a seed; this is why it is extremely important that you only speak positive things and look for something positive to happen in your life. This is why you do not surround yourself with negative-acting and negative-speaking people. Remember: you must watch who you allow to speak into your life. You must be careful who you allow to feed your spirit. The person that you buddy with may be the very person who is always influencing you to speak negatively every time you encounter a problem in your life. He may be the type of friend who advises you to divorce your wife and leave your children because you are unhappy with your marriage. He can speak from experience because that is what he did. Only he does not tell you the whole truth. There are people who hide their mistakes by lying. He did not tell you how he regretted his decision and that, by the time he came to his senses, his wife would not take him back. Her love had turned to hate. His wife only wants to see him destroyed for betraying her. The only reason why he sees his son on the weekend is because his wife is putting the needs of her son before her need for retribution. The change in her did not take place until after their son was arrested for drugs and the drug counselor said that his father might have a better influence over him. When your friend visits his son, he can still see the hatred in his ex-wife's eyes.

You do not have to worry about God's promises. You do not have to wonder if His promises will come to pass. He will supply you with employment, with a business, with shelter, and he will supply you with the necessities of life. You cannot forecast peace and prosperity into your life if you do not believe and have faith in God. You will not have the confidence to believe that your future harvests will be greater than any harvest you have seen before. Do not be like your friend who betrayed his wife and neglected his son. Do not allow his negative thinking to

contaminate your faith. Make the decision to believe God then follow His instructions.

Make demands upon God according to the word of God. God has said, "Command ye me." You worship a functional God who demands intimacy. You must spend time in God's word so that His words can influence your thinking. Consider how many hours you spend watching television. Now compare this to the number of hours you spend reading the word. If there is a disparity between the two, this means that you need to spend more time reading God's word. God's word is refreshing. He tells you not to worry about tomorrow. He tells you to bring Him your dreams and desires. God's word will keep you from disaster. **Psalms 17:4:** As for the deeds of men by the word of your lips I have kept myself from the ways of the violent. **Psalms 119:105:** Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light for my path.

Put God in Remembrance of His Word

Set forth your case, justify your request Frame your order to God; say: this is my order to God.

I declare it unlawful for me to die before my promised years.

I have the authority to forbid or permit.

I am healed, wealthy, and successful.

I permit deliverance. I will make myself prosperous with my mouth.

I forbid tragedy to come upon me

I give the blessing permission to remain.

I forbid the storm to destroy my property.

I permit the storm to go back to the sea.

Jesus Said I Can Do Whatever You Believe

Angels are waiting for my permission. I can bring certain things to pass with my permission.

When you walk in the light, you can make demands in the name of Jesus. Jesus made this promise to you. He said he would do what you ask for the glory of God.

Do Not Lose Your Vision

Because we are constantly being bombarded with the words of the world, we must stay fixed on the word of God. Every day we see failure, strife, poverty, and hatred. These despairing images are imparted to our soul. Since we see these negative things, we must replenish our hope so that we will continue to believe that all things are possible through God.

God is waiting for you to use your faith. You are going to have to start in faith, stay in faith, and finish in faith. Love is your Christian duty, and faith works by love. When you believe that God loves you, your behavior will show it. My faith shall look like my life. Faith can be seen. Faith is a spiritual substance that can be transformed into the physical world and that can be seen in a person's action. Faith is a heritage that can be passed on to your children. But sin blocks faith. Do not let the inheritance you pass to your children be sin rather than faith, like King Ahab. King Ahab passed sin down to his children this is why all his children perished. His children did not recognize the presence of God in their lives. They ignored God's teachings and refused to worship Him. They too did not want to take their daily dose of castor oil for their guidance and protection. See we do not always want to abide by God's word we want to avoid the pain of forgiving our enemies, giving to the poor, and paying our tithes. We want to watch football on Sunday rather than attending church. Too often we want to feel justified in our anger at our boss or our jealousy of our neighbor. Reading the Bible to help us with anger hatred and jealousy is our daily dose of castor oil. Yet if we live in faith and abide by God's will we know our lives shall end as a testament to God's wonder. Stay in faith!

Hebrew 11:1 Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen...we understand that the world was framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.

Mark 2:1-5 (Faith should be seen) Many were gathered together... and there was not room...they uncovered the roof where he was: and when they broke it up they let down the bed wherein the sick of palsy lay.

Proverbs 13:20 You stay in faith by avoiding those that do not believe. He that walketh with wise men shall be wise: but a companion of fools shall be destroyed.

Isaiah 43:26 Put me in remembrance; let us plead together: declare thou, that thou mayest be justified.

Put God's words in your mouth. Your words are seeds. If you plant them, they will grow. You want a bountiful harvest, so watch the words of your mouth. Never speak in anger to anyone. Settle it with yourself that anger is a dangerous emotion which can lead you to destruction. Practice speaking positively to yourself during the day. If you are stuck in traffic, find something to rejoice about. Congratulate yourself for a good day's work. Spend that time blessing your children or praying to God for guidance. But the very thing not to do is to agonize over the traffic jam until you become so frustrated that by the time

you get home, you are so angry that you cannot greet your family properly. Your mouth gives expression of your choices. Examine the following scriptures; they are some of the choices God made by His statements. God spoke an entire world into existence. No strife was found in His mouth. Can you not follow His example? **Proverbs 3:5** says, *Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding*. You know for certain that man is a spirit and that we communicate with God through our spirit. Well, transformation in our lives comes from bringing a manifestation from the spirit world into the physical world. This transformation is accomplished when we speak God's word and plant this word in our heart as seed. Please read

1 Corinthians 2:9-16:

However, as it is written: 'No eye has seen, no ear has heard, no mind has conceived what God has prepared for those who love him'— 10but God has revealed it to us by His Spirit. The Spirit searches all things, even the deep things of God. 11 For who among men knows the thoughts of a man except the man's spirit within him? In the same way no one knows the thoughts of God except the Spirit of God. 12 We have not received the spirit of the world but the Spirit who is from God, that we may understand what God has freely given us. 13 This is what we speak, not in words taught us by human wisdom but in words taught by the Spirit, expressing spiritual truths in spiritual words. 14 The man without the Spirit does not accept the things that come from the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him, and he cannot understand them, because they are spiritually discerned. 15 The spiritual man makes judgments about all things, but he himself is not subject to any man's judgment: 16 For who has known the mind of the Lord that he may instruct him?'

But we have the mind of Christ. Now read the passages again.

Man is not the body he possesses; he is a spirit being housed in a body. It is through his spirit that he communicates with His creator to bring the world he desires into existence. Every year you may see something in your life that you want to change. When you require change in your life, go to God's word and speak your world into existence.

Just as God spoke the world into existence, we can speak manifestation into existence in the physical word. We were made in God's image, so we can bring our world into existence by speaking just as God did. Here are some passages God spoke.

God, You Said...

Deuteronomy 28:1 And it shall come to pass, if thou **(you)** shalt hearken diligently unto the voice of the Lord thy God, to observe and to do all His commandments which I command thee this day, that the Lord thy God will set thee on high above all nations on this earth.

Joshua 1:8 Be sure that the book of the Law is always read in your worship. Study it day and night, and make sure that you obey every thing written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful... I have commanded you to be determined and confident.

Psalm 5:11-12 But let all those that put their trust in thee rejoice; let them ever shout for joy, because thou defendest them: let them also that love thy name be joyful in thee. For thou, Lord, wilt bless the righteous; with **favour** wilt thou compass him as with a shield.

Luke 10:19 God has give unto **me** power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy; and nothing shall by any means hurt **me**.

Put God's words in your mouth.

Now I say: By his stripes I am healed, God shall supply all my needs, I shall have what I say, ...

Acts 10:34 I now realize that it is true that God treats everyone on the same basis. Those who fear him do what is right and acceptable to Him no matter what race they belong.

Mark 11:20-23 They saw the fig tree dried up from the roots. Master behold, the fig tree which thou cursedst is withered away. And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God...and shall not doubt in his heart ... he shall have whatever he saith.

You must make a commitment with yourself to bring God's word into your life. You feed your faith (mind) by: reading, listening, studying, and using your imagination. Striving to make good decisions in life will help to build your faith. Remember all of the benefits available to you when you are obedient to God's word. Your need to feel superior should not override your common sense.
